The proposed energy corridors encroach on numerous dark-sky areas in several western states. These dark sky areas are important resources for both professional and amateur astronomers. I am opposed to any activity that reduces the air quality or increases light pollution in these areas because it would have an adverse impact on the public's access to the night sky. Development and construction activities in these areas should be required to meet the strictest guidelines for particulate emissions and lighting should be of a quantity and type that does not increase sky brightness outside the immediate area of the corridors.
