**Comment Submitted:**

I would urge you to move the Energy Corridor from it's designated location In Indian Springs Nevada 89018 for historical reasons. The path now designated cuts a swath through the privately owned Indian Springs Ranch, which was first developed in the late 1800's. The oldest buildings in our community can be found there, some constructed of adobe, others of railroad ties from a now-defunct railroad, the Tonopah-Tidewater. The source of drinking water for the ranch and irrigation water are right in the middle of the corridor as currently designated. If the corridor was moved slightly south to run behind what we call "Graqundpa Mountain," impact on this historical area would be avoided.
