The preliminary draft maps of the potential energy corridors within Colorado that currently available at <http://corridoreis.anl.gov/eis/pdmap/index.cfm> are at such a small scale that it is impossible for our office to determine whether the proposed undertaking will affect historic properties currently listed on, eligible for listing on, or potentially eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).

Thousands of cultural resources (including sites listed on or eligible for the NRHP) have been recorded within the 19 Colorado counties identified on the map as containing portions of the potential energy corridors (Moffat, Rio Blanco, Garfield, Mesa, Delta, Montrose, Dolores, San Miguel, Gunnison, Chaffee, Fremont, Montezuma, La Plata, Bent, Pueblo, Routt, Grand, Clear Creek and Gilpin). Our files contain incomplete information for this area, as most of Colorado has not yet been inventoried for cultural resources. As a result, there is the possibility that as yet unidentified cultural resources exist within the potential energy corridors.

We look forward to additional consultation with the federal agencies regarding the effect of this undertaking on historic properties within Colorado and would like to review finer scale map data in GIS format for our state when it becomes available.
