Dear Ms. Souder:

On behalf of ExxonMobil Pipeline Company (EMPCo), we would like to submit the following comments on the above referenced Notice of Intent:

We request that you consider designating all the existing interstate and intrastate pipeline infrastructure, as identified in the Department of Transportation's (DOT's) National Pipeline Mapping System, as energy corridors. In addition, all pipelines currently in the permit application process, and potentially others, should also be considered for inclusion in the energy corridors. We suggest that you contact DOT's Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA) for more understanding of the hazardous liquid pipeline program. PHMSA can provide valuable information in order to assist you in scoping the Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement for hazardous liquids pipelines.

Even though we have not had sufficient time to determine and submit a request to designate energy corridors for our future pipeline capacity needs, attached for your information are two maps indicating the location of our pipelines in California and Montana.

EMPCo supports the comments and recommendations submitted by the American Petroleum Institute (API) and the Association of Oil Pipe Lines (AOPL) concerning this Notice of Intent.


