In reference to the June 2006 Draft map plotting potential corridors:

Due to the poor quality of the map very little specific information about the planned routes is discernable.

The GIS people that constructed the map have mis-ordered the layer display such that the private lands layer covers the actual proposed pathways of the corridors. Because of this it is impossible to understand the routing.

More reference points are needed, such as county boundaries. It would also be helpful to see special designations like wilderness areas, wild & scenic rivers, etc.

Please post ESRI shapefiles of the potential corridors, so that individuals and groups in the public can make informed study of the proposals.
