The California Independent System Operator Corporation ("CAISO") would like to identify additional new corridors that would accommodate potential projects as approved by or proposed to the CAISO, or of which the CAISO is aware. The projects requiring new or expanded corridors are:

(1) Captain Jack/ Marlin - Bay Area 500kV Project (Conceptual need under consideration by CAISO); (2) Midway - Gregg 500kV Line (Proposed by PG&E to CAISO in annual expansion plan); (3) Conceptual Frontier Line (Conceptual project under consideration by regional partners); (4) Tehachapi Transmission Plan (CPCN filed by SCE); (5) Vincent - Mira Loma 500kV Line Project (Proposed by SCE to CAISO in annual expansion plan); (6) Palo Verde - Devers No. 2 Project (Approved by CAISO Board) Sunrise/Green Path Project; (7) (Proposed by SDG&E to CAISO in annual expansion plan); (8) LEAPS Project (Associated with generation project in CAISO interconnection queue). The corridors associated with these projects are set forth in the attached map.
