Indian Springs is a small community of about one square mile, crowded between Creech AFB on the north, Grandpa Mtn on the south, & BLM property east & west.

Indian Spgs citizens suggest the proposed 230 kV line be given right-of-way south of Grandpa Mtn on BLM land identified as "Segment D" on the project route map. This would give Valley Elec Assn the land they require & create no additional hardship on Indian Spgs, the springs the town is named for, plus century-old trees & bldgs. Valley Elec. has looked at the suggested re-routing & agrees it is as good or better plan than the one through Ind. Spgs. & that it would not increase cost for utility poles or wires. The citizens of Ind. Spgs would feel much safer, healthwise, without this high voltage line through our settlement.
