While it is difficult to determine from the Draft Energy Corridor Map the number of acres of state trust surface and mineral resources that could be affected by this initiative, we have no specific concerns at this time. However, we would like to emphasize at this early stage that, notwithstanding the federal NEPA process or federal approvals, the project proponents must comply with the Rules and Regulations adopted by the Board of Land Commissioners in accordance with W.S. 36-2-107 and W.S. 36-9-118, in the event the proposed corridor will traverse state lands.

We look forward to the opportunity to review the Draft Programmatic EIS which will afford this office an opportunity to examine West-wide Energy Corridor proposal in more detail.
